## ABOUT ZANZIBAR

Zanzibar, an archipelago of many small islands, is a semi-autonomous area of Tanzania lying some 25 miles off the coast of the Indian Ocean. The two main islands are PEMBA Island, to the north, and the larger southerly UNGUJA Island, or Zanzibar as it's widely known. Around two thirds of the 1.5m population live here, with most settled in the densely populated west. Outside of a handful of main towns, most people live in small villages - trading, subsistence farming, or living off the sea.

The reefs are rich in marine biodiversity, making them ideal for snorkeling and diving and with miles of beaches of the softest whitesands, fringed with coconut palms, it is a classic tropical paradise.

On its main island, Unguja, familiarly called Zanzibar, is Stone Town, a historic trade center with Swahili and Islamic influences. Its winding lanes present minarets, carved doorways and 19th-century landmarks such as the House of Wonders, a former sultan's palace. The northern villages Nungwi and Kendwa have wide beaches lined with hotels.

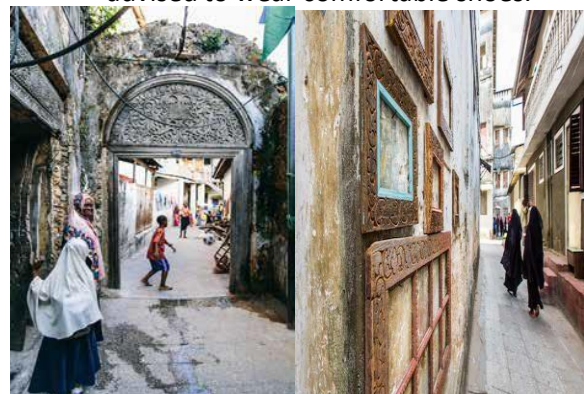

### Did you know?

During the reign of the Omani Arabs in the early 19th century, Zanzibar was the main slave trading point of East Africa. Slaves bought and caught on the mainland were shipped to Zanzibar, where they were resold and further transported to Seychelles, Mauritius, Oman and Persia.

Prison Island takes approximately 30 minutes to get there by boat from Stone Town.

The prison was built on this island in 1893, it was later used as a quarantine hospital.

It has a frangipani lined path around the island where the former patients took their evening walks. Apart from the prison ruins you can also see the beautiful peacocks and the giant tortoises, some of which are over 100 years old. It is also a way to see Stone Town from the sea.

### JOZANI FOREST

The Jozani Chwaka Bay National Park is a 50 Km<sup>2</sup> national park located on Zanzibar island.

It is the only national park in Zanzibar. This forest is inhabited by the Zanzibar Red Colobus, an endemic monkey species that exists only in Zanzibar.

Jozani Forest boasts a rich diversity of native wildlife, including swamp forest, evergreen thicket and mangrove. Red colobus monkeys are endemic to Unguja. These monkeys are very playful and you can easily get close to them. Monkeys can be seen frolicking amongst the exotic indigenous flora. Spend some time wandering through the forest and discover its hidden secrets.

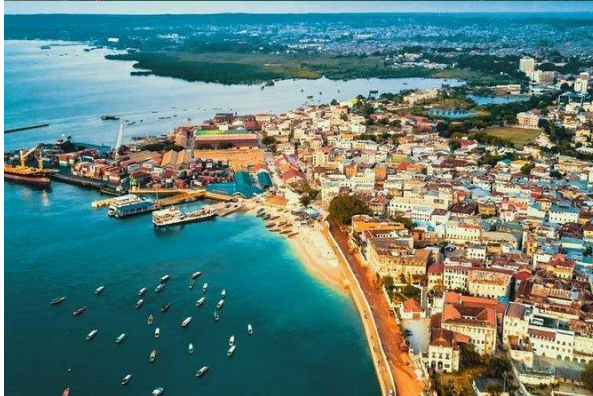

Prison Island is so called because of its first usage as a prison, which was built in 1893. But in fact it was later used as a quarantine hospital and is nowadays the home of the giant tortoises which were banned from the city of Stone Town.

Enjoy a 30-minute boat ride with a view of the Stone Town Skyline, after arriving on Prison

Island your guide will teach you the history and introduce you to the giant tortoises.

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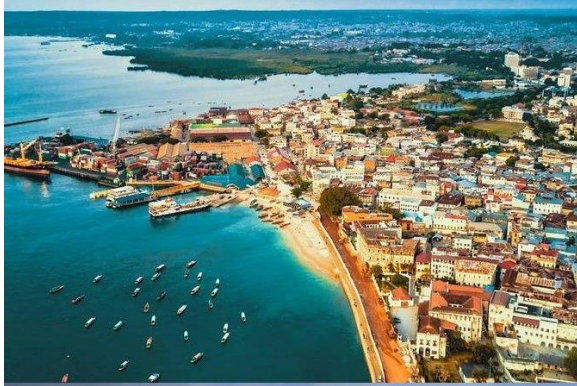

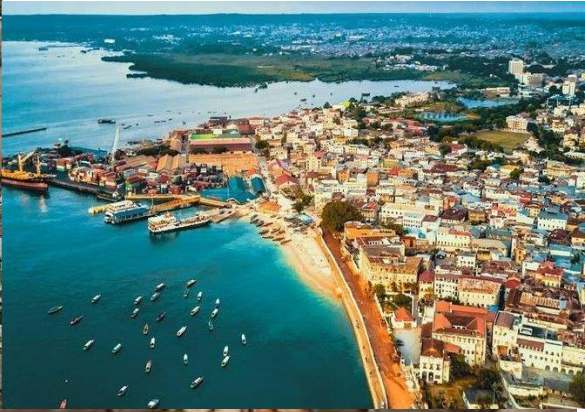

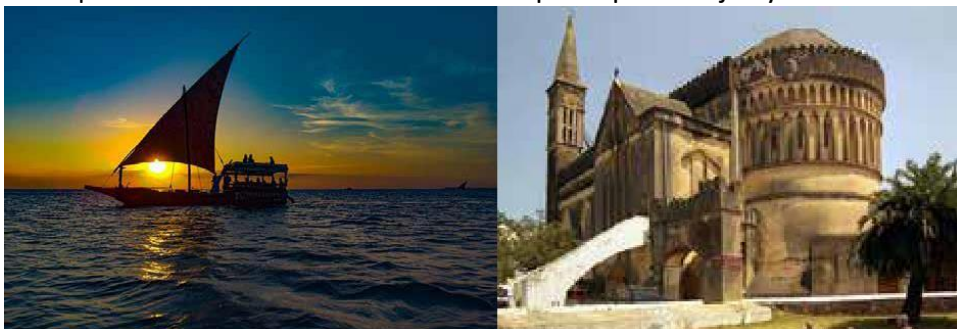

The beautiful Zanzibar Butterfly Centre near Jozani- Chwaka Bay National Park

This community project aims to protect endangered species of butterflies, to educate both local people and visitors, and to provide an income for villagers. Set in 5000 sq/ft of beautiful gardens only 5 minutes by car from the Jozani Forest, it offers the opportunity to see butterflies very close (they might even settle on your hand!), to feed them and to learn all about their fascinating life cycle.

### **JOZAN FOREST**

Jozani Forest's 44 sq km, about 3% of the whole island, comprise groundwater forest, coastal forest and grassland, as well as mangroves and salt marsh on the coast. It provides a habitat for a wide variety of mammals, birds and butterflies. A walk through this impressive flora and fauna is one of the highlights Zanzibar has to offer. The reserve has excellent nature trails, and our English, French, Spanish, Italian and German speaking guides are well trained and informative.

# SELOUS GAME RESERVE

A UNESCO World Heritage Site

The Selous is the largest Game Reserve in Africa; four times the size of Serengeti - covering 54,600sq km, more than 5% of Tanzania's total area and larger than Switzerland. It possesses a diverse landscape from hot volcanic springs, sporadic lakes, channels from the Great Ruaha and Rufiji rivers'

The Game Reserve was named after Frederick Courteney Selous, a British explorer and hunter in East Africa who was killed in World War 1 in the Beho region of the reserve. The area has remained one of the untouched gems of Tanzania's national parks and game reserves.

There are large populations of elephant in the park. Approximately 70% of Tanzania's elephants are found in this reserve. Other well-known animals include the hippo who inhabit the river systems, depleted numbers of the black rhino, large herds of buffalo, lion and the area's rare and endangered wild dogs and patrol the Reserve. Also found here are Nyasaland gnu, brindled gnu, hartebeest, Greater Kudu, sable antelope, eland, reedbuck, bushbuck, waterbuck, warthog, zebras, giraffe, wildebeest, leopard, cheetah are rare. There are over 350 species of birds including African snipe, Bataleur eagle, Crested lark, Green-headed oriole, Knob-billed duck, herons, kingfishers, geese and Southern Ground hornbill. Reptiles such as crocodiles and various snakes and lizards are also found.

- Women's henna body painting available in salons around Stone Town
- 'Mkoba'-Woven Baskets
- Recordings of local music eg. Taarab, Jambojambo, etc Wood carved doors and chests
